Healthy Home Resources Renews AT HOME Program for Fall 2007

Pittsburgh, PA, Thursday, October 15, 2007 -

Healthy Home Resources AT HOME, Asthma Trigger Home Evaluation Program, renews this fall with grants from The Pittsburgh Foundation, The Birmingham Foundation and The Grable Foundation. The AT HOME Program is an indoor, environmental hazard program that focuses on identifying and eliminating indoor asthma triggers found in the home. The program is provided, free of charge, to qualified families with children between the ages of 4 and 17 who have asthma. Through five in-home visits the Healthy Home Resources staff inspects the home for triggers such as allergens, mold, pollens, insects, pests, pets, dust, and other triggers.

The AT HOME Program was initiated in 2004 with a \$1.26 million grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Healthy Home Resources worked closely in the City of Pittsburgh and surrounding communities, serving over 200 families in City Development Block Grant (CDBG) territories over the course of three years. With a history of consistent success Healthy Home Resources is excited to continue serving families in need. By providing over \$1000.00 worth of cleaning supplies and remediation services Healthy Home Resources helps reduce and eliminate asthma triggers in homes, making breathing, and life, easier for hundreds of children with asthma.
